



Dickinson County Conservation District

Objective:

This scholarship is intended to encourage qualified students to increase their interest in conservation, to obtain technical competence in some phase of conservation, and to pursue a career in this area of endeavor.

Eligibility:

An applicant for the scholarship must be: (A) a senior enrolled in a Dickinson County high school or a graduate from a Dickinson County high school with a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or greater (on a 4.0 point scale); and (B) enrolled as a full time student in an agricultural or natural resource conservation-related curriculum such as agronomy, range management, forestry, geography, agricultural journalism, agriculture education, or wildlife management. Other areas of study related to conservation and agriculture may also qualify.

Specifics:

The Dickinson County Conservation District awards up to two, individual, \$1000 scholarships annually. The first half of the scholarship, in the amount of \$500, is awarded at the beginning of college enrollment. The second half of the scholarship, in the amount of \$500, is awarded upon documented, satisfactory completion of one semester and enrollment for the following semester. Satisfactory completion is defined as maintaining an average grade point average of 2.0 or greater (on a 4 point scale). Scholarship recipient must provide documentation to the Dickinson County Conservation District within 30 days of semester end to receive remainder of awarded monies.
